When: Thursday March 30,2023

Interview: Monday March 27, 2023 @ 6pm at Fairgrounds Grey Building

**Pattern: 2 patterns judged March 30,2023 @ 8:30am- First pattern is the practiced pattern
Second pattern will be posted at TNLS Horse Show**

Where: Barney Wiggins Rodeo Arena

Practice Night: Required 1 of 2. All horses will be validated on your practice night. As required by the rules you must practice on the horse in which you will compete on. You will be given the judged pattern at the first practice. Any questions regarding practice will need to be addressed before the first practice date.

Friday, February 3, 2023 @ 6:30pm

Friday, March 3, 2023 @ 6:30pm (if needed)

Interview Requirements: 40% of total score. You will be asked to give a short introduction (1-2 minutes) about yourself before questions are asked. Attire will be a long sleeve white western shirt, black jeans or slacks, hat, and boots. Standardized Interview type questions and general horse knowledge questions will be asked.

Horsemanship: 40% of total score. Attire will be the same as interview. Chaps are optional. Contestants will be required to complete two patterns. One horsemanship pattern that will be given to you at our practices and one pattern posted the morning of the Horse Show March 30, 2023 in which you will be judged with other Sweetheart Contestants during the Horse Show. The pattern the night of the Rodeo will not be judged.

Presentation: 20% of total score. Contestants will be judged on their overall appearance and presentation (ie: attitude, behavior) during the week of TNLS.

Bonus Points: Contestants will be given bonus points for the following:

Assist in passing out Ribbons and Awards: 15pts

- At the practice night you will be given an event in which to help pass out ribbon and awards

Complete a poster and have it on display at the show: 20 pts

- Turn in on **Monday March 27, 2023 at Interview**
- A rubric will be available for guidance

Results: Results will be announced after all have completed their pattern ride at the Rodeo starting at 6pm. Contestants should be **ready at 5:45 at East end of the arena for presentations.**
